If you or anybody in your household or anybody that you have been in contact with displays symptoms of Covid19, you must not attend school.

Public Health Agency (PHA) Close Contact Information

If you have been identified as a 'close contact' via 'HSCtracing' text or through the StopCOVID app you need to self-isolate for 14 days.

Self-isolation means you must stay at home and not leave the house for 14 days.

Does this mean I will definitely get COVID-19? No but you are at risk - a 'close contact' is a person who has been close to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.

How long do I need to stay at home? 14 days
As a close contact you need to self-isolate at home because you are **at risk of developing symptoms in the next 14 days** and could spread the virus to others before the symptoms begin.

If you develop symptoms book a test.
