COVID INFECTION CONTROL REMINDER

- High Temperature, New / Persistent Cough, Loss of taste or smell Stay at home, isolate and book a test. <u>https://covid-19.hscni.net/testing</u>
- \succ Inform school immediately and advise us of the result as soon as possible.
- Pupils do not return until symptoms have gone for at least 48 hours even if the test result was negative.

Where a child has been in school it is essential that Parents inform the School by email immediately if they becomes unwell with Covid symptoms or are being tested, even if the result is negative.

- > It is very important that we have the most up-to-date contact details for parents and carers especially if we need to contact you during the school day.
- If during this period of sustained lockdown, you have changed your mobile number, email address or home address we ask that you email Mrs Shannon in the School Office with your updated contact information.
