

Goodbye to Our Primary 7 Pupils



remind all Parent/Guardians about the importance of the percentage attendance of your child that will be indicated at the front of the school report. **Additional information from the Department of Education regarding school attendance is copied below.** We hope that the parent/guardian of any child who has attendance below 95% (95% attendance is regarded as satisfactory) will address this issue during the incoming 2022/2023 School Academic Year.



EUERY SCHOOL DAY COUNTS -

Every single day a child is absent from school equates to a day of lost learning.

Attendance percentages can be misleading.

100% Attendance	0 Days Missed	Excellent
95% Attendance	9 Days of Absence 1 Week and 4 Days of Learning Missed	Satisfactory
90% Attendance	19 Days of Absence 3 Weeks and 4 Days of Learning Missed	Poor
85% Attendance	28 Days of Absence 5 Weeks and 3 Days of Learning Missed	Very Poor
80% Attendance	38 Days of Absence 7 Weeks and 3 Days of Learning Missed	Unacceptable
75% Attendance	46 Days of Absence 9 Weeks and 1 Day of Learning Missed	Unacceptable

For some parents, 90% may seem like an acceptable level of attendance, but the reality is that 90% attendance means that your child will miss half a school day each week or 19 days of school during the school year – that's nearly 4 school weeks.

Congratulations to our TT Rock Stars



The Education Authority has provided an update on the 2022/23 application process for Free School Meals and School Uniform Allowance. Applications for the support available should be made before 31st July 2022 to ensure that everything is in place for the new school year in September. Parents/Guardians who are currently in receipt of support for the 2021/22 school year will receive a letter highlighting the need to apply for the 2022/23 school year and the process to do so.
