

Primary 1 – Primary 3 and Primary 4 – Primary 7 School Sports Day

Our School Sports Day will take place in Cregagh Sports Ground (behind Iceland) on Tuesday 11th June 2024. Parents are warmly invited to attend but please note we are unable to provide seating for spectators. **In the event of sports day being cancelled due to inclement weather the same lunch arrangements will remain in place and all P1 - P3 children will go home from school at 12.15 pm**. Sports races will then be run off in school as and when timetabling permits – unfortunately it will not be possible to invite Parent/Guardians to watch if this is the case.

Board of Governors Parent/Guardian Questionnaire - Issued to Eldest Child on 22nd May


As we approach the end of the current 2023/2024 School Year we would like to thank you for your continued support. As Parent/Guardians you play a vital role in your child's education and your child benefits greatly when you support the work going on in Harding Memorial Integrated Primary School. All schools are required to review their progress and achievements against the targets they set in their School Development Plan for the previous year. Harding Memorial is no different to other schools in this respect and considerable work is completed by Harding Memorial Teaching Staff and Non-Teaching staff during the August Baker Days & School Development Days.

We are approaching the end of our Three Year School Development Planning Period from 2020/2021, 2021/2022 & 2023/2024 and therefore we feel that it is very important to consult with each Parent/Guardian as an essential "stakeholder" about our future school priorities in order that we can start to plan and continue to improve the school learning environment for everyone. Indeed, you and your child(ren) as members of our school community were and are the focus for all forms of School Development. Targets and plans are centred on improving the experiences for the children and on raising standards, particularly in Literacy, Numeracy and ICT (Information and Communications Technology).
